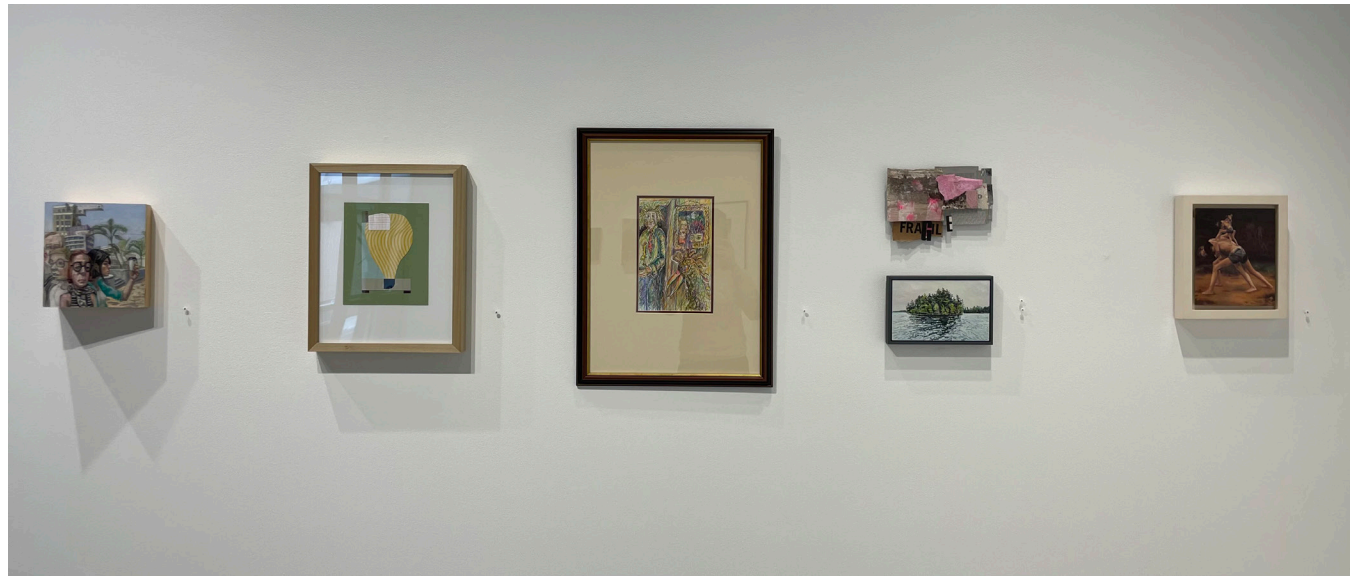


SMALL WORKS NATIONAL JURIED EXHIBITION

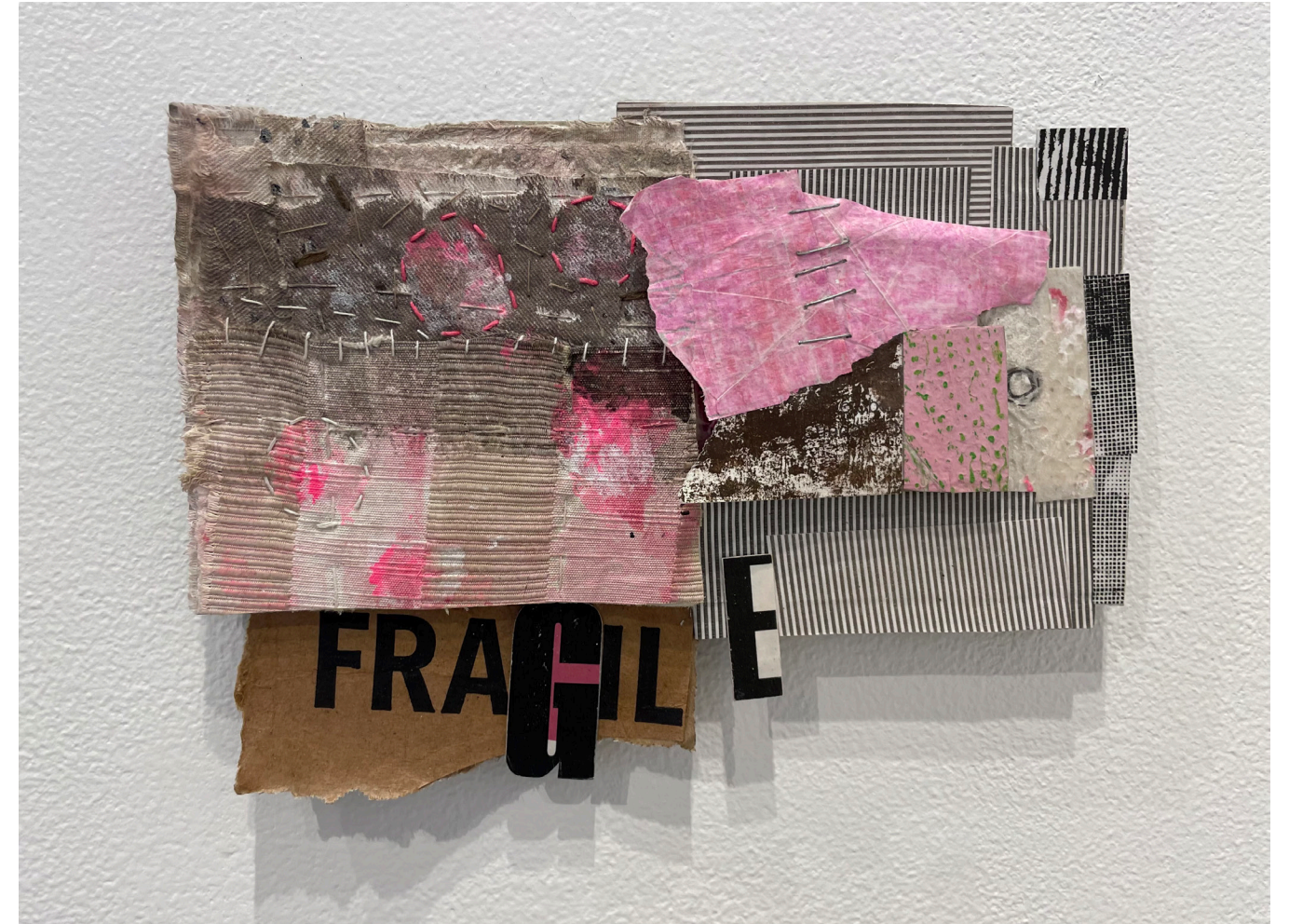

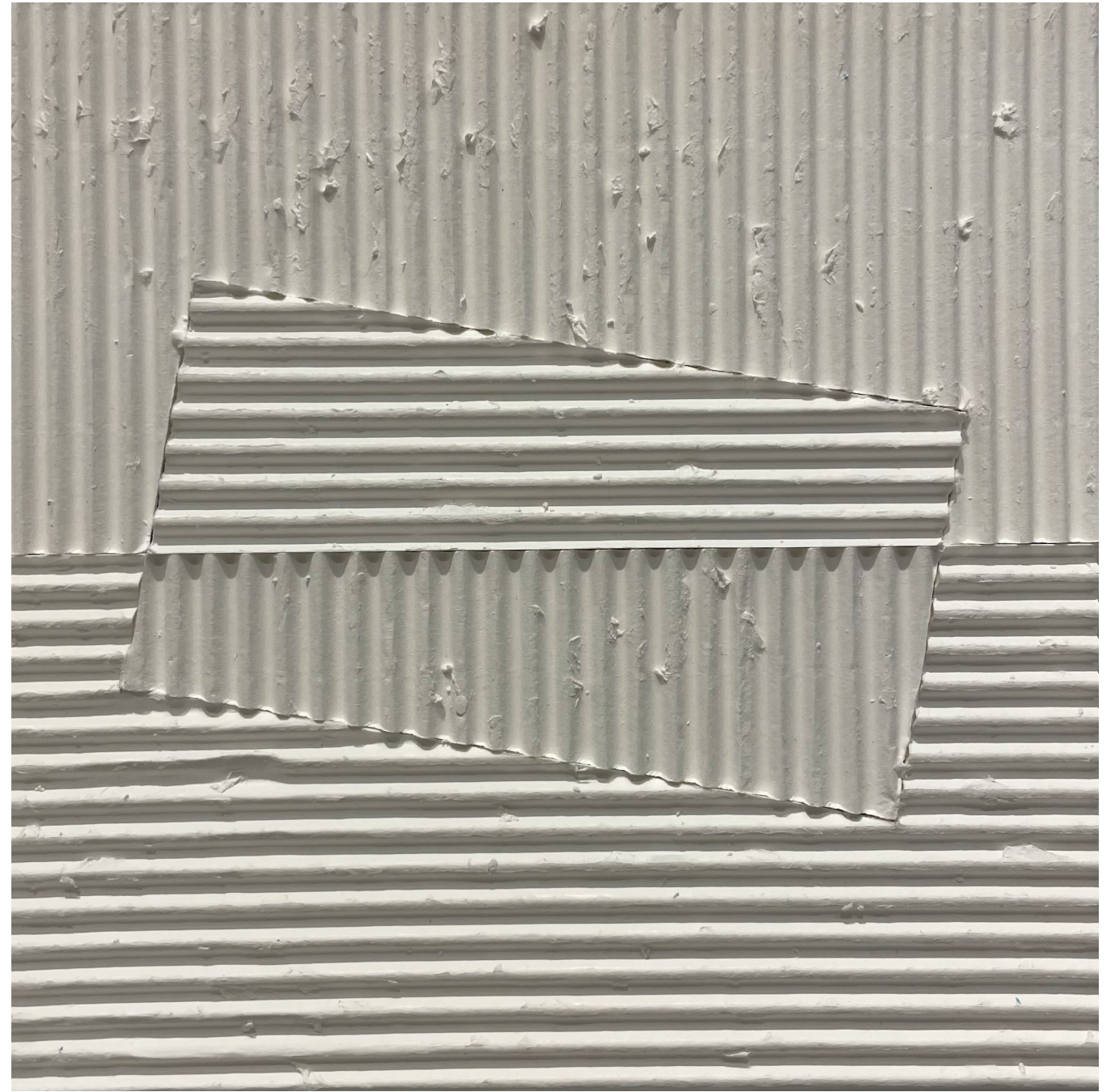

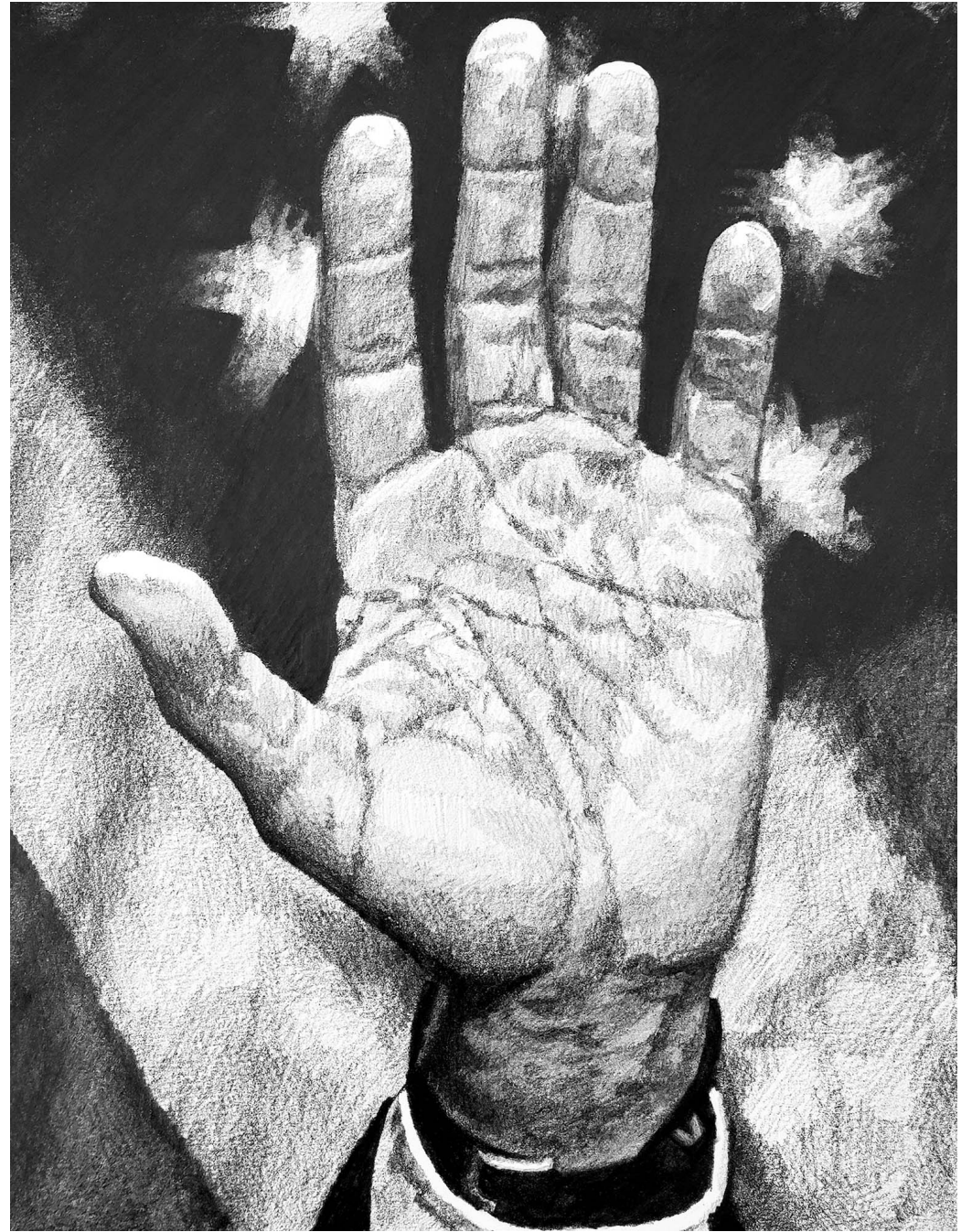

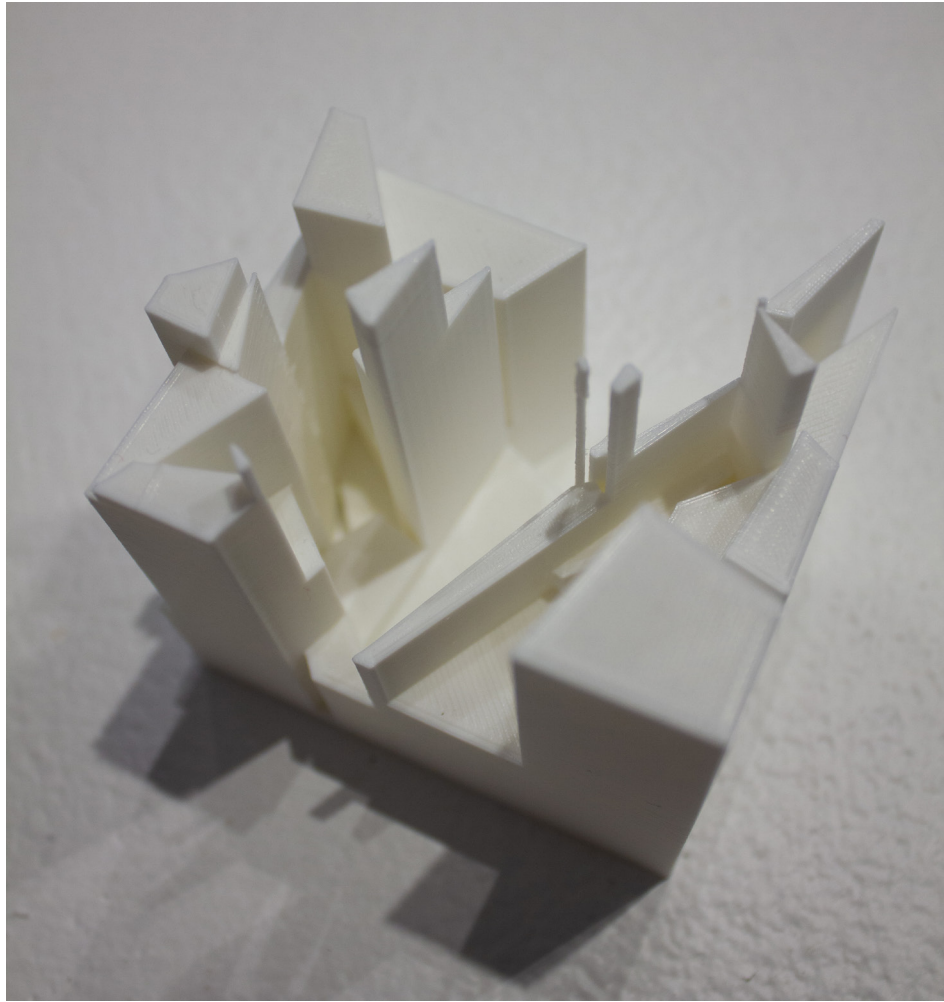

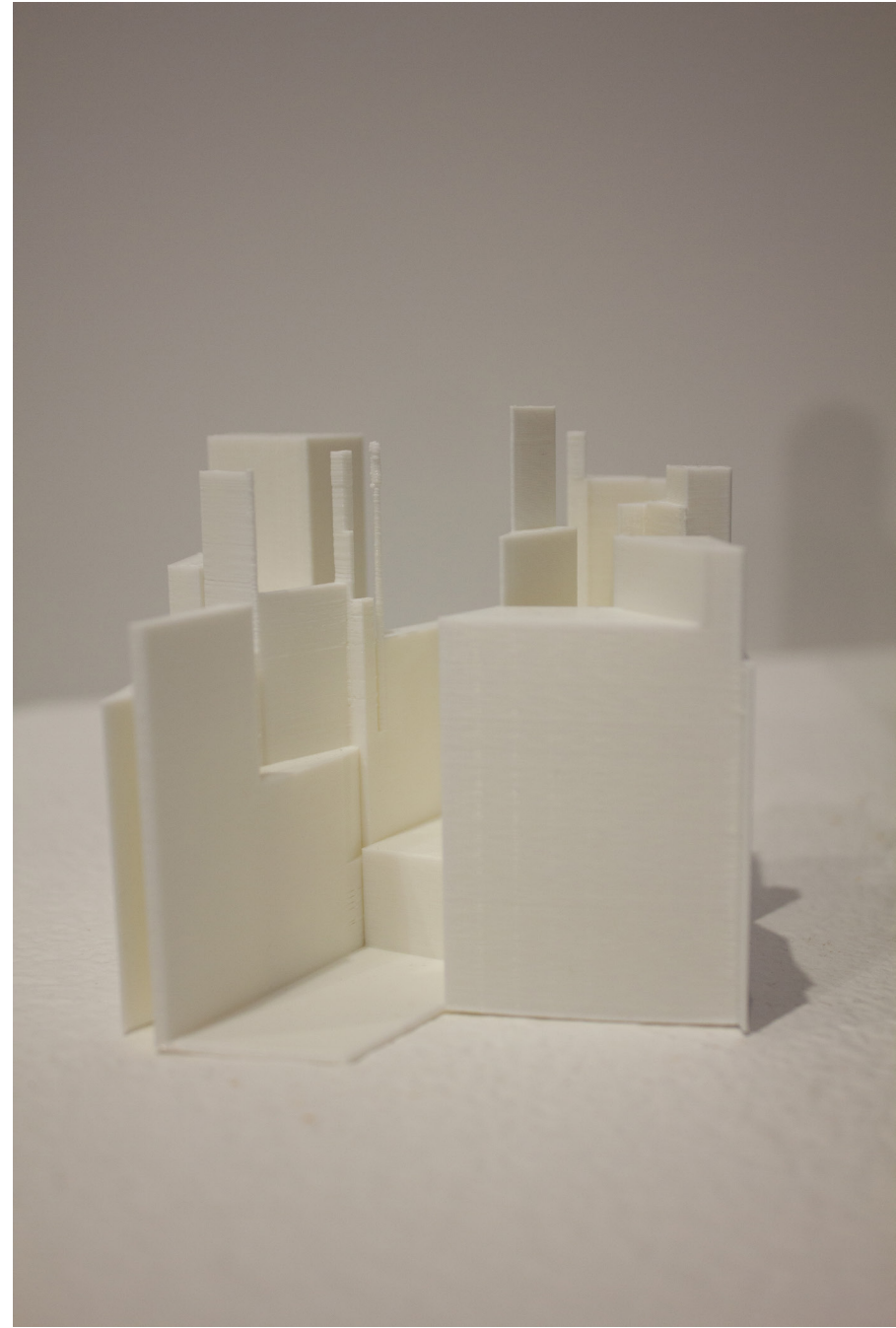

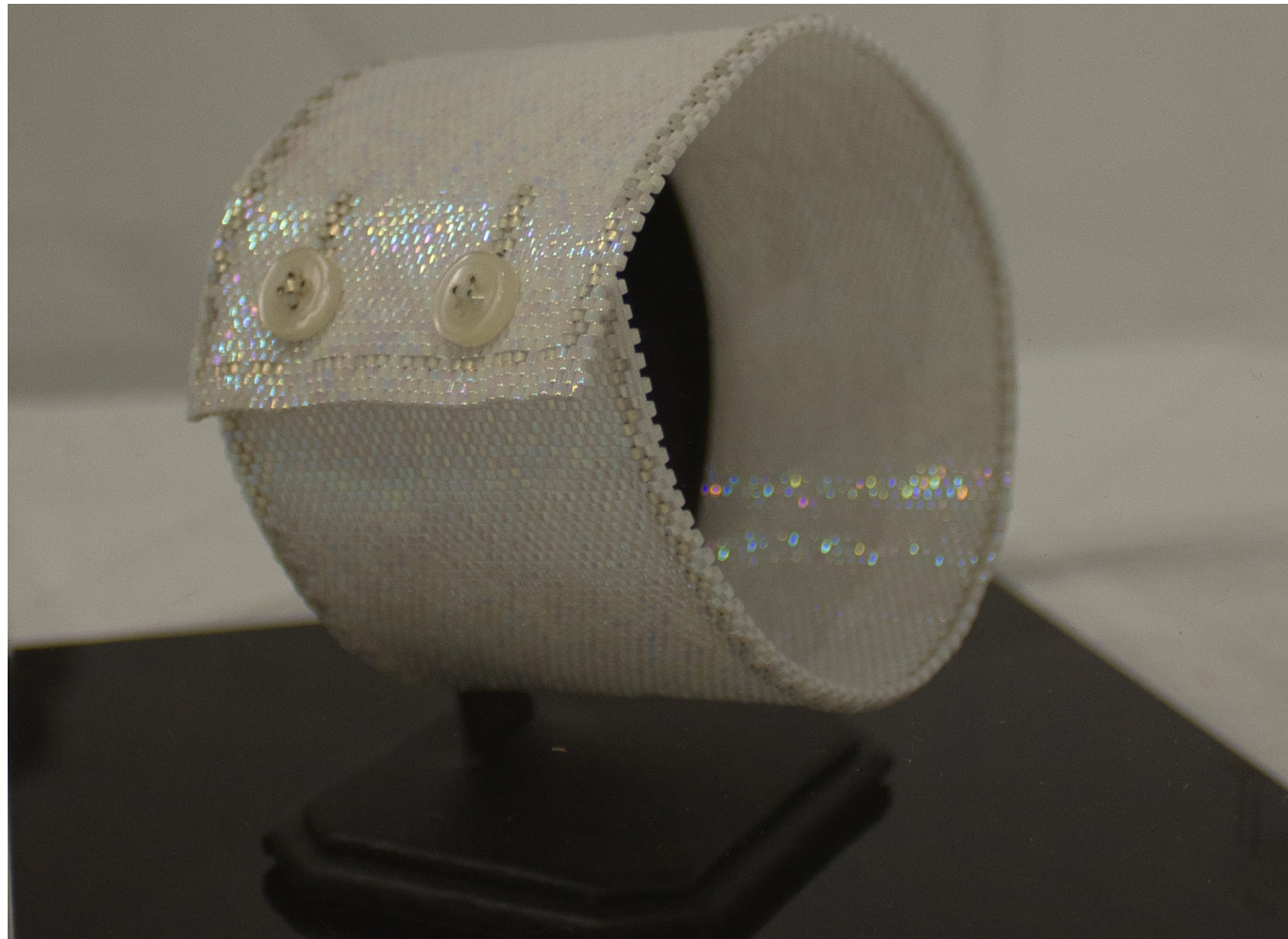

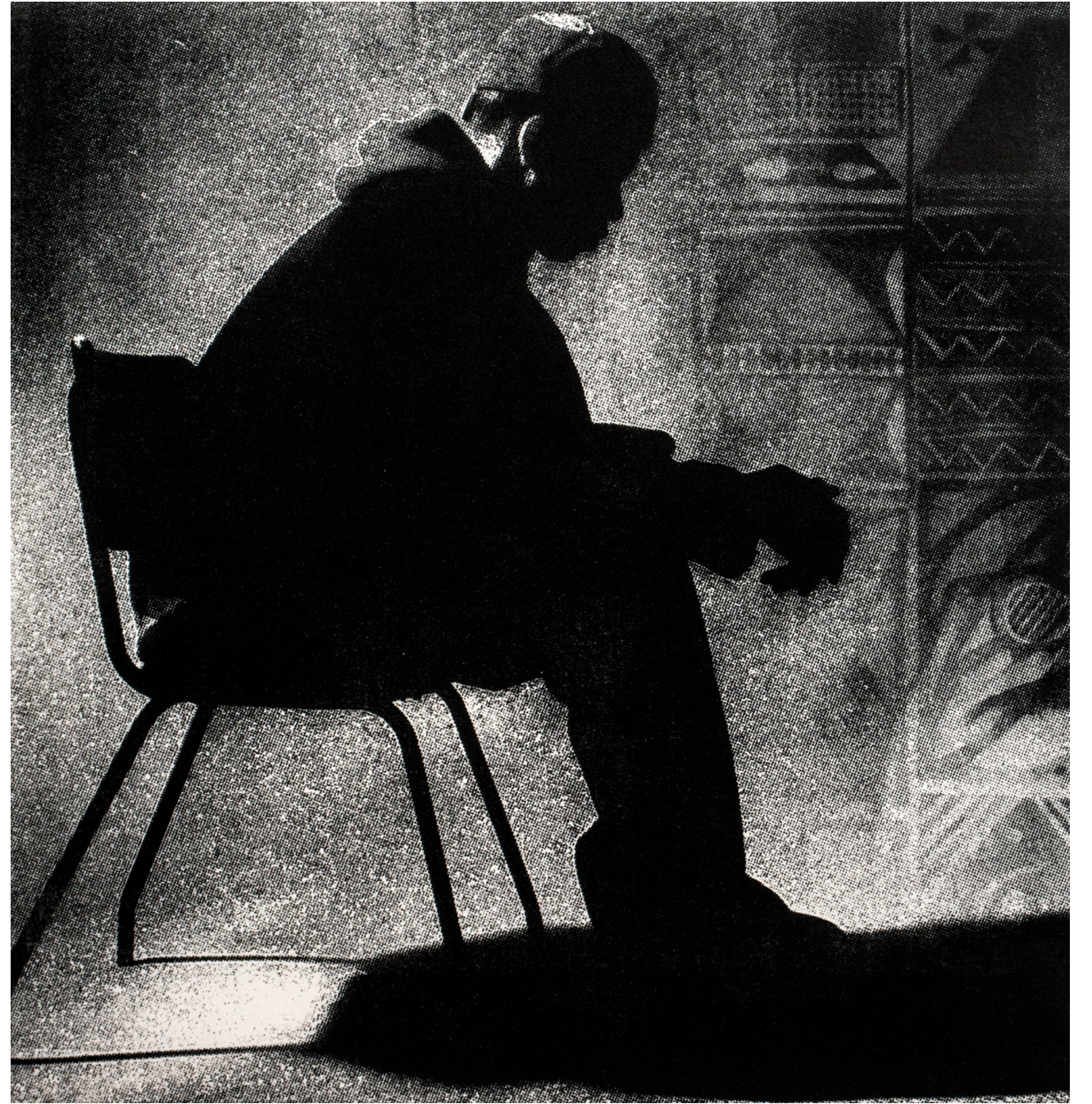
